

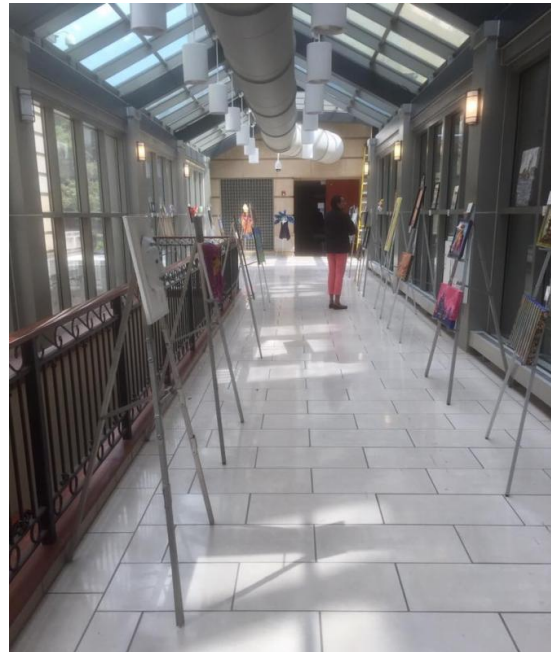
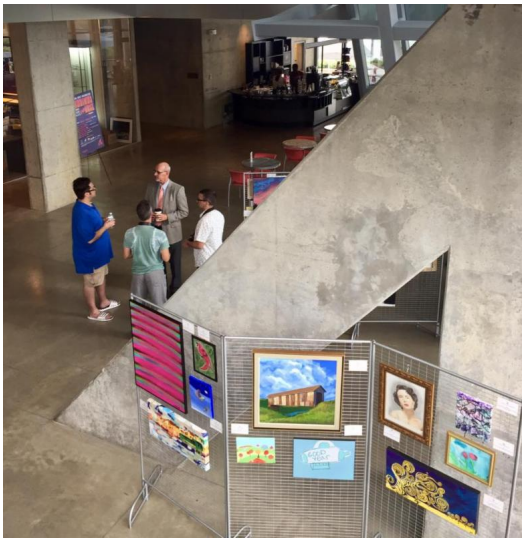

Akron, OH 44313. The day will include booths, break-out sessions and other activities targeted to seniors, their caregivers, and their families.

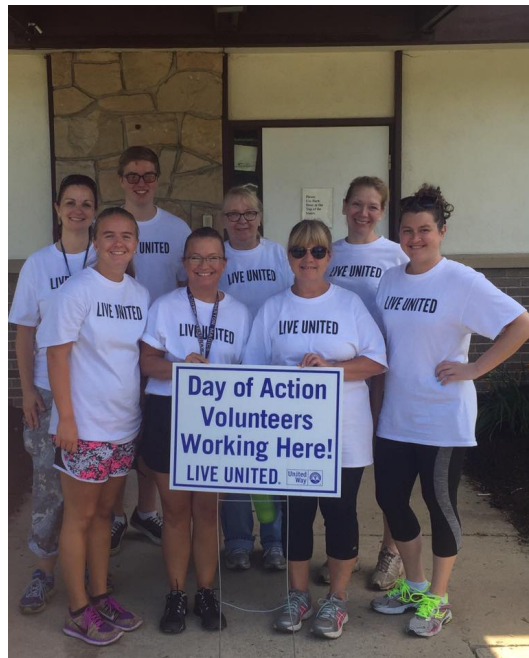

### United Way Day of Action

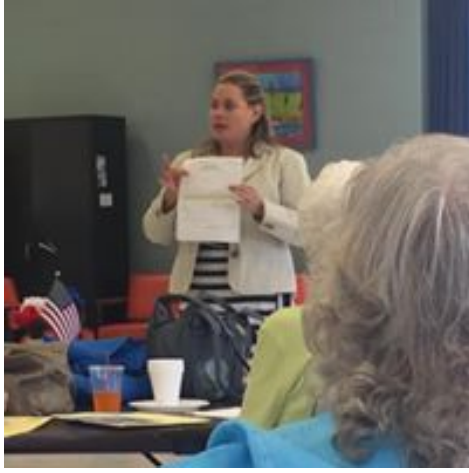

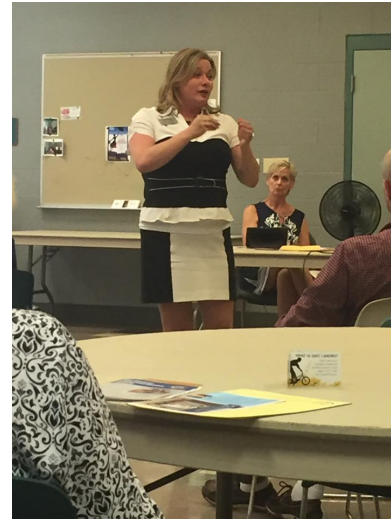
The most unique speaking engagement was for the Brock Family Reunion. A family
